ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Registration opens for the 2009/2010 school year on Tuesday, December 2, 2008 for current (as of 11/26/2008) Temple Sinai partners and on Monday, December 15, 2008 for our currently enrolled students and their siblings for Early Childhood through 8th grade. Registration opens to the community on Monday, January 5, 2009.
- Registration for 2009/2010 cannot be accepted until full payment of tuition for this current school year is received (unless prior arrangements have been accepted) and the family fund-raising commitment has been paid in full.
- Deposits:
 Prior to February 1, 2009, Kindergarten through Grade 8 admission forms must be accompanied by a \$2,000 deposit.
 K through Grade 8 admission forms received after February 1, 2009 must be accompanied by a \$2,500 deposit.
 Early Childhood Education forms must be accompanied by a \$500 deposit.
- When any particular grade reaches its capacity, a wait list will be compiled. Temple partners are given priority for any spaces that become available for wait-listed students.
- Academic/Achievement and Development Assessment is carried out for all students entering Kindergarten. This is not an 'acceptance test,' but is purely diagnostic. Its purpose is to enable us to place your child with the appropriate teacher, and to have a clear picture of your child's emotional and cognitive development. It gives you a better understanding of your child's strengths and weaknesses, and is essential for us to provide the level of teaching appropriate to your child. The cost of the test is \$350 and is paid directly to Solutions Educational and Psychological Services, an independent agency. The screening will take place at school shortly after registration. Pre-admission Academic/Achievement and Developmental Assessment screening is required for each student entering Jacobson Sinai Academy in grades K-8 for the first time.
- Applications for all NEW students MUST be accompanied by a copy of the child's birth certificate.

REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED WHEN ALL FORMS ARE COMPLETED AND SIGNED.

- 1. Communication Acknowledgement**
Initial _____ I/We, _____, represent that we have affirmatively advised Jacobson Sinai Academy (the “school”) of any and all issues that may otherwise influence _____’s abilities or his/her ability to interact with other students or that may interfere with the ability of fellow students to learn. Should it be discovered that _____ is affected by any of the foregoing issues or any such similar issues and, prior to enrollment, notification was not provided to the Academy, the school reserves the right in its sole and arbitrary discretion to suspend or expel the student.
- 2. No Refund Policy**
Initial _____ I/We understand and accept that Jacobson Sinai Academy of Temple Sinai of North Dade Inc. does not refund registration fees, deposits, tuition fees, or any other payments to the school, if we decide to remove our child(ren) from the school after registration, except in the following circumstances: where the school has counseled us to withdraw our child; where we have applied for a Visa to enter the USA and been refused; where we had hoped to move to the area but are no longer able to do so; where we are moving away from the area for a job or to make *aliyah*; or where an offer of financial assistance is insufficient for us to meet all payment obligations.
- 3. Payment Acknowledgement**
Initial _____ It is agreed that payments of all tuition and fees will be received on time. It is understood that Jacobson Sinai Academy has the right and responsibility to make every effort to assure the on time collection of all outstanding balances due and may, in cases of non-compliance, elect to terminate the relationship. I/We agree to pay all costs of collection, including reasonable attorney’s fees, in the event that any payment hereunder is not timely made and it becomes necessary to utilize the services of an attorney, whether suit be brought or not.
- 4. FACTS - Tuition Collection**
Initial _____ For the 2009/2010 school year we have contracted with FACTS Management Company to electronically process our monthly tuition payments. All families must be registered with FACTS no later than May 1st with the first payment due on May 20th. You may choose the 5th or 20th of each month for your payment to be processed and an annual fee of \$41.00 per family will be charged.
- 5. Parent Clause**
Initial _____ I/We agree that a positive and constructive relationship between the school, student and family is essential to the fulfillment of the school’s mission. Thus, I understand that the school reserves the right to withdraw an offer of enrollment at any time and not to extend the privilege of enrollment or re-enrollment to a student if the school reasonably concludes that the actions of the student, parent or family member make such a positive and constructive relationship impossible or otherwise seriously interferes with the school’s accomplishment of its educational purpose. Moreover, if deemed to be in the best interest of the school, the school also reserves the right to withdraw an offer of enrollment at any time before the beginning of the academic year covered by this contract and, in such an event, will refund all tuition paid.
- 6. Name, Photograph, Information**

OTHER FEES:

SECURITY SURCHARGE - Temple Sinai has been in the forefront in our community of implementing the highest level possible of safety and security for the protection of all who enter our campus and for our physical plant. Our staff and lay leadership are fully committed to continuing to ensure the highest standards. The security surcharge will be as follows:

- TEMPLE SINAI PARTNERS: A MINIMUM OF \$350 per family
- TEMPLE SINAI NON-PARTNERS: A MINIMUM OF \$450 per family

DISCOUNT POLICY - There is a \$250 reduction in tuition for the second child in a family and for each additional child.

FAMILY FUNDRAISING - Each Kindergarten - Grade 8 family is responsible for participating in a minimum fund-raising commitment of \$500 in each school year.

MATERIALS FEE - A Materials Fee of \$350 is charged to each student in Kindergarten - Grade 8. This fee covers all textbooks, workbooks, field trips (except overnight class trips), and consumable materials.
