The time to register your child for next school year is already upon us, and we are excited to be sending out registration information for 2010/2011 earlier than in previous years. Our goal is to assist you in securing a place for your child at what is widely regarded as one of the best private schools in South Florida.

You will see that there is just one registration form, for all grades from ECE through Upper School; you will only need to fill in those parts that apply to your child. **Registration opens to the public on Monday, January 4<sup>th</sup>.**  
*A birth certificate is required for all new students.*

**To enroll your child(ren), please include a deposit check for \$2000 made payable to Temple Sinai with each completed registration form.**

Please enroll now; the sooner we know our numbers for next year, the more prudently we can budget, and in doing so continue to raise the quality of the education we provide, both inside and outside the classroom. Please note that the published tuition fees offer an 'Early Bird' rate until January 31, 2010.

**On February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 all Day School tuition fees will increase by \$750;** please see the registration package for details.
